FROM THE PASTOR

Many people throughout the country think it odd that the dioceses in the Northeast still celebrate Ascension Thursday on the Thursday before the Seventh Sunday of Easter. The Ecclesiastical Provinces of Philadelphia, New York and Boston (and all their dioceses, including Harrisburg) are the only ones that do this in the United States. All other provinces celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension today. The reasoning is that so few people come to Mass on the Holydays that it is best to be able to preach about this important event in the life of Jesus to the most people possible. It is understandable but, at the same time, if we did that, we would not be able to hear these beautiful readings for the Seventh Sunday of Easter. From the Acts of the Apostles, we see the Apostles and the Mother of Jesus gathered in the Upper Room praying and waiting for the Holy Spirit to descend upon them. In our Gospel, we hear Jesus' final prayer for his disciples in that same Upper Room before his death and resurrection. Praying. Waiting. Knowing that the Lord Jesus is still interceding for us to the Father. These are the things that strengthen our faith and give us hope in this world of ours. May we learn patience, may we learn how to pray, and may we believe with all our hearts that Jesus is on our side. Without these things, how could we ever get through this "valley of tears"?

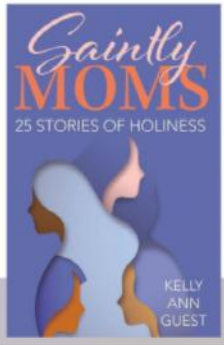

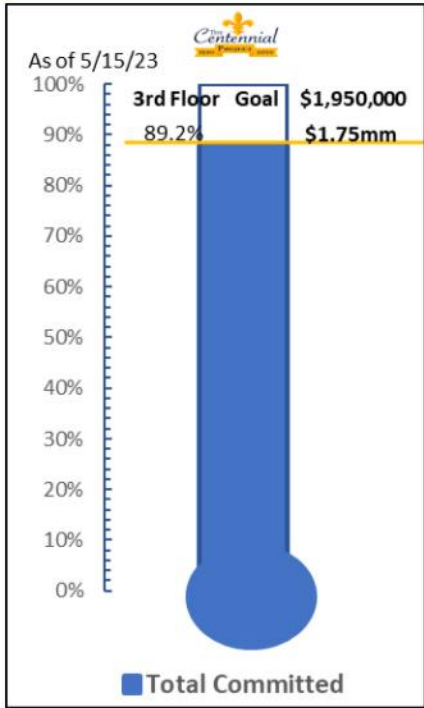

Construction Updates:

Hopefully in the next two weeks we will have acquired our building permit to start our 3rd floor renovation project. Purchase orders have been issued. Materials are on their way (so far, through God’s grace, there are no “supply chain issues”!)

The first task at hand is the sorting, purging, and movement of stored items on the 3rd floor from the areas identified for construction activities to temporary storage areas elsewhere on the floor. It’s crazy how fast things accumulate. If you have your current youth protection clearances, and have some daytime or daylight evening hours available to volunteer, any help you could give in this “housecleaning” effort would be greatly appreciated. The last day of class is June 9th. That is the target date for the installation of the framing, HVAC, plumbing, and wiring to begin in earnest. The first day of class for the fall semester is Tuesday, September 5th. The schedule will be tight.

Our Centennial Project will end its solicitation phase at the end of this month. We will continue pledge collection and posting our progress on the thermometer.
