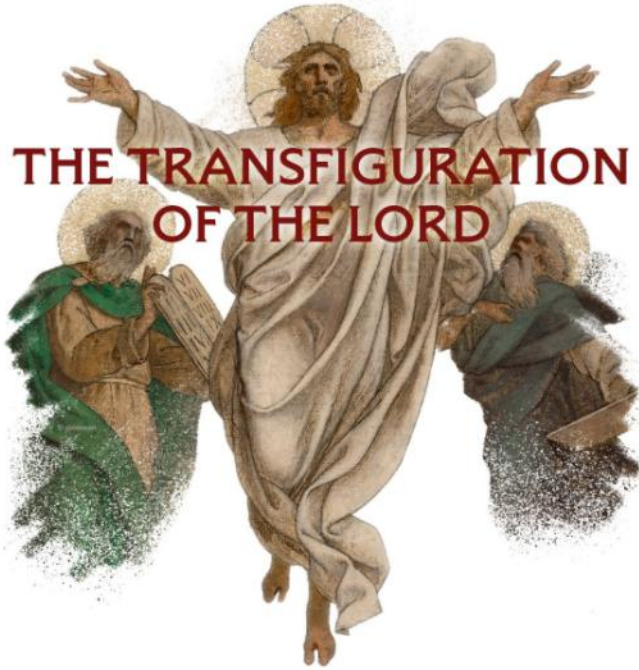

THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD



Today is the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. This feast has such importance in the life of the Church that it takes the place of the Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Saint Thomas Aquinas tells us that this miracle is unique among all miracles in that it happens to Jesus. He is transfigured on Mount Tabor in the presence of not only the apostles Peter, James and John but in the presence of those Old Testament figures Moses and Elijah. It is a meeting place between the divine and the human, the mundane and the other-worldly. Moses and Elijah, the great Lawgiver and the great Prophet, represent the People of Israel acknowledging the Messiah for whom they were waiting. The very Law and the Prophets were pointing to Jesus to be the place of contact, between this world and heaven. The Apostles represent the Church who acknowledge Jesus as Lord and who are shown a glimpse of the glory that Jesus shares with all humanity through his death and resurrection. God is such a good and loving God that he allows us to share in his life—both on this earth and forever in heaven. The main message of Christianity and of the Gospel is that if we want to know the Father, we must come to know and love the Son. Quite extraordinarily, we Christians believe that in the face of Jesus we see the face of God!
