

we at Saint Joan of Arc have beautiful, reverent celebrations of the Holy Mass, not in small part due to our music ministry, our well-trained liturgical ministers (MCs, altar servers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, lectors) and, of course, you, the assembly who bring your deep faith to each Mass! Pope Francis encouraged Eucharistic Adoration to enhance our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. I want to thank all of you who take time each First Friday for adoration in the Saint Lucy Chapel. I encourage more of you to take part in monthly adoration. (I especially call each ministry in the parish to take some time each First Friday to pray in front of the Exposed Blessed Sacrament for the success of your ministry, for our parish and for our Church.) On September 24, 25 and 26, we will have our Annual Eucharistic Devotions. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar in our church from after the 9:00 AM Mass to the closing each night at 7:00 PM. Father Josh will be our preacher during these important days. May we make time for Jesus in the Eucharist, "the source and summit of our faith!"


