

At the beginning of today's Mass, before the blessing of the palms, the priest introduces Holy Week with these words:

"Today we gather together to herald with the whole Church the beginning of the celebration of the Lord's Paschal Mystery, that is to say, of his Passion and his Resurrection."

Holy Week is a special time in the life of the Church. We walk with Jesus from his triumphal entry into Jerusalem, through the days when his betrayer seeks a way of leading him to the authorities, to the Last Supper and the washing of the disciples' feet, to the arrest, trial and death of the Lord on the Cross, to his rest in the tomb when all had seemed lost, to his glorious Resurrection on Easter Sunday. In the 4th century, a Spanish nun by the name of Egeria made a pilgrimage to the Holy Land and wrote an account of the Church's celebration of Holy Week. In many ways, what was done then (and even before that) is what the Church continues to do to this day. It is amazing how ancient the rites of Holy Week are! Of course, these events are not merely historical, to be recalled each year in pious memory. No, we are to enter into the very Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus and make his way of humility our very own. As Saint Paul tells us, "If we die with Christ, we shall rise with Him!" May this Holy Week be a time of intensified prayer, penance and a true understanding of what is at the very heart of our Christian Faith. Have a blessed Holy Week!


