Sacrament of Marriage: Call the office 9 to 12 months prior to the proposed wedding date.

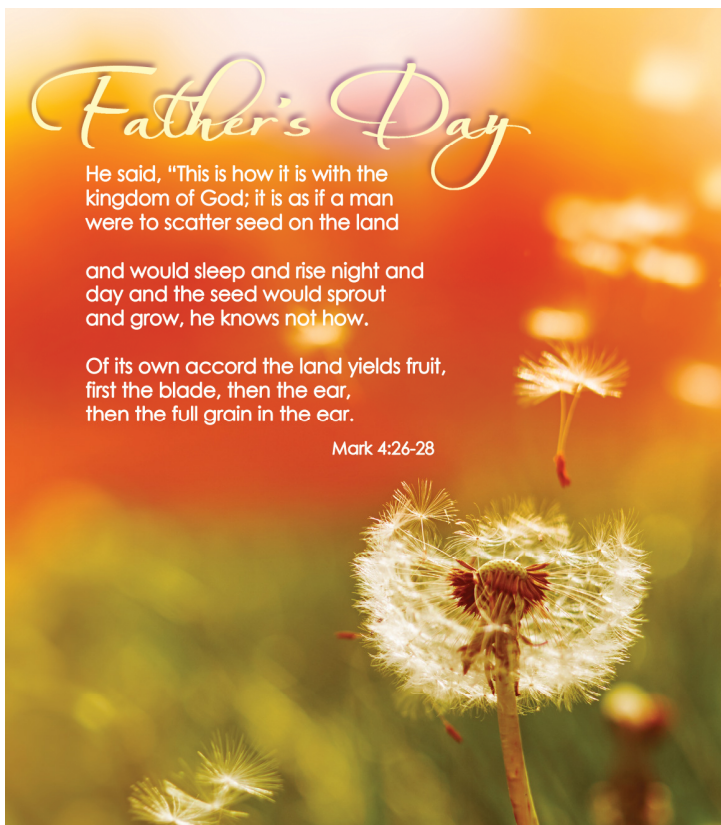

NATIVITY OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST

Is 49:1-6; Acts 13:22-26; Lk 1:57-66, 80

Called from birth by the Lord, John matured in the Spirit and heralded the advent of the Messiah. *This feast, dating from the 4th c. in both East and West, came to be celebrated, in accord with Lk 1:36, six months before the Lord's birth; quoting Jn 3:30, Augustine found this date (near the summer solstice) appropriate for, after the birth of John, daylight begins to grow shorter, whereas after Jesus' birth, it begins to increase.

VOCATIONS CORNER

We welcome the newly ordained Fr. Kenneth Roth to our parish as parochial vicar on Monday June 18. So, what does it mean to be a "Parochial Vicar"?

Parochial vicars are assigned by the bishop to assist the pastor in the care of the faithful. The Code of Canon Law defines the office as follows: "Parochial vicars are priests who render their services in pastoral ministry as co-workers with the pastor in common counsel and endeavor with him and also under his authority" (545.1). Given the size of some parishes, parochial vicars are essential in helping the pastor fulfill his obligations for the spiritual and temporal welfare of the parish. Please pray for all of the priests who have received new assignments that they may carry out their ministry after the likeness of the Great High Priest, Jesus Christ.
