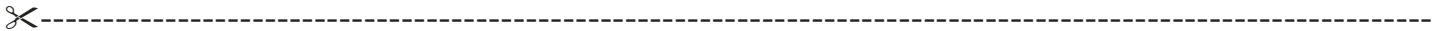
NEW ALTAR SERVER REGISTRATION FORM
