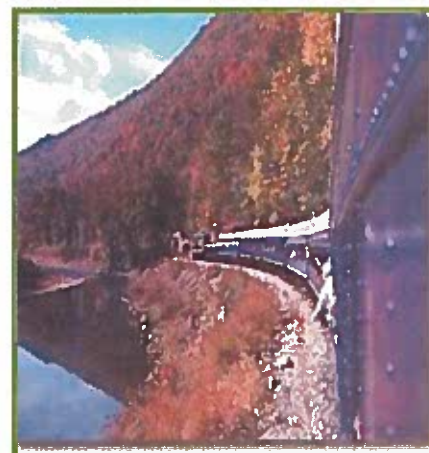


Areba Club Presents:
