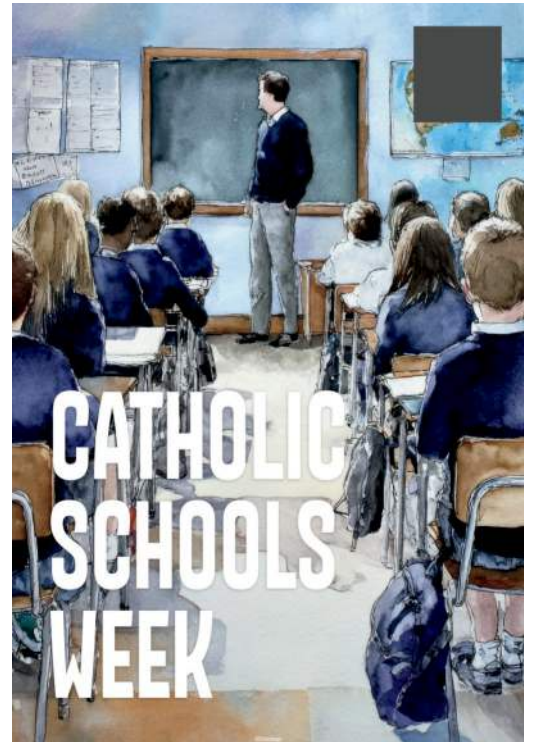

I am so proud of this parish! Not only did we meet our DAC goal for 2025, but we went over by **\$28,000!**

Our assessment was \$296,406.14 (I love the .14), which is the largest in the diocese and not only did we surpass that goal, but we did so without using anything from savings. It was all of us together who made this happen. The parish will be reimbursed the \$28,000 (actually, it may be more than that because the DAC ends this month and there may be a few more payments that come in) and we can use it as we see fit. What a nice place to be! Big thanks to all who donated this past year and made this possible. I want to thank in a special way the **75 families** who made a pledge for the first time or after several years of not giving. The more who give the easier it is to reach our goal. After collectively patting ourselves on the back, we need to take a deep breath and move onto this year's DAC. I am glad to tell you that our assessment only went up a few thousand dollars.

The 2026 goal is **\$299,971**. We can do it again if we all work together. I want to once again encourage **all of us** to make a one-time gift or pledge to be spread out over an entire year. When we all work together, amazing things can happen! Again, my heartfelt thanks to all of you in supporting the mission of the Church through our support of our diocese. You are great!

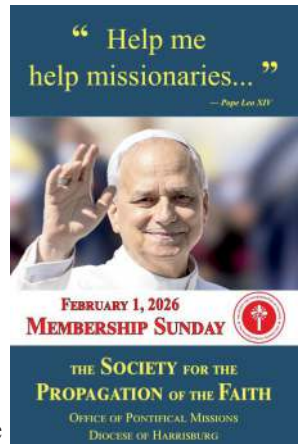
