# FROM THE PASTOR

How many of you remember your First Holy Communion? I remember it being a time of eager anticipation, a day of beautiful spring weather, and a party with my family in the afternoon. My first time receiving the Holy Eucharist was at the regularly scheduled 8 AM Mass on Sunday morning. In many ways, if possible, it is better to celebrate First Holy Communion on a Sunday because it makes the connection between receiving Jesus in Holy Communion and Sunday, the day we are obligated to come to Mass and making the Lord's Day a special day of rest. All the boys were on one side of the aisle, and the girls were on the other side. I was the first to receive for the boys because I was the shortest...or was it because I was the youngest? I don't remember the reason, but I had the best seat in the whole church! Monsignor Conrad, who was the pastor at the time and has been since 1945, seemed rather formidable to me but it was from him that I received Communion for the first time and who heard my first confession. (I will always remember what he said: "That was a very good confession, but you don't have to give me all the details. Just tell me your sins." Good advice to everyone!) I didn't have any kind of great spiritual experience at my First Holy Communion, but it was the beginning of my life being fed by the Lord. This weekend, the children of the parish received their First Holy Communion. May it not be their last! Parents are the first teachers of the Faith to their children. Passing on the Faith needs to be done in words, but the more powerful way is through deeds. Coming to church each and every week (even on vacations) and being strengthened for the trials of the week ahead by receiving Jesus in the Eucharist is the best way that parents can hand on the Faith to the children God has lent them in this life. Congratulations to all of our children who made their First Holy Communion and thanks to the parents who are handing down the faith in words and in deeds!
