SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



FROM THE PASTOR

Today is the Seventh Sunday in the Season of Easter. It is the Sunday between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost Sunday. Many dioceses in the United States transfer the Feast of the Ascension to this Sunday but I am glad that we are one of those dioceses that do not. It would be easier, I think, to celebrate the Ascension on this Sunday, but then we would miss an important lesson. It is the lesson of what to do in the "in-between times". Every life has times like this. We are looking forward to something that is coming in the future (a wedding, an ordination, a baby, a career change, etc.) and at the same time we realize that what is past is past. We can't change that. So, what do we do in those times in between (which to be honest is most of our lives)? We do what the disciples in the Upper Room did. We wait and we pray. We learn patience and we pray for the strength to accept the future with its uncertainties and unknowns. We often think this is boring and unproductive but in reality it is what makes us strong in our faith and able to face whatever comes our way - good or bad. I don't think we appreciate this part of life too much. We obsess with either the past or the future. We forget to live in the now! The now is when life happens. It is when God teaches us, He is in control and patience is the only way of learning this. It is when we begin to realize that prayer is not something WE do but rather something that GOD is doing in us. Patience and prayer. These are the two non-negotiables in the life of a Christian. Sitting in an "upper room" of our own and praying and patiently waiting for God to reveal himself is the lesson of the day. All good things come to those who wait-and pray.
