Learn what you **MUST** know about the topic of Physician Assisted Suicide.

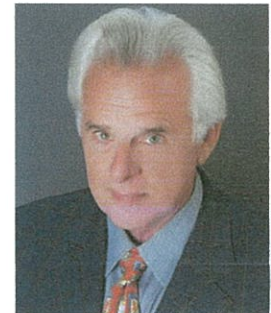


Rev. Tad Pacholczyk
